19.4. GROVES

19.4.1. A GROVE consists of three or more people who meet regularly, at least once per month, and have received a Charter as a Keltrian Grove.

to read:

19.4. GROVES

19.4.1. A GROVE consists of three or more people who meet regularly, at least **12 time per year, or** have received a Charter as a Keltrian Grove.

Reason for change:

To allow for groves to take off during the summer months or not have a ritual during any month and still maintain their Grove status. Also, to allow that once a grove is chartered it remains as a grove as long as the charter is maintained.
